

EMERGENCY EVACUATION

SAFETY RULES

During an emergency:

STAY CALM

Follow these instructions upon receiving alert sign:

- Prepare to evacuate the building.
- Secure all personal belongings.
- Switch off computers.
- Stop all experiments.
- Stop all treatments to patients.

 **Do not use the lifts.**

Assist any person with a disability to leave the building or to the nearest fire stair to the assembly point - do not attempt to carry the disabled person. Please use a stretcher or a wheelchair.

Walk quickly and calmly to the designated assembly point or as advised by the emergency response team, fire warden or other authority. A designated fire route signboard is available at each floor.

Remain at the assembly points (in groups) until instructed to leave by a fire warden or authority.

 **Do not re-enter the building until informed that it is safe to do so by an emergency warden or authority.**

Assembly Point



In emergency situations our response to different people's needs may vary.

There may be people who have a visual or hearing impairment; have difficulty with mobility or standing; use walking aids or a wheelchair; pregnant; have heart conditions; asthma; experience panic attacks; or are claustrophobic.
